

This is another excellent commentary in the New Collegeville Bible Commentary series. Short but compact, O'Connor gives descriptive commentary on each chapter of the book of Job without sounding preachy or too dogmatic. The sections are short and informative, and well edited. The only thing I'd change about the book would be the translation used, the New American Bible, Revised Edition. Chapter 3:1 of the book of Job for instance, reads.. "and cursed his day." (pg.15) A more accurate translation would inform the reader that Job in fact, cursed the day he was born. "His day" doesn't really convey the essential meaning of the verse. But overall, a short and easy readable commentary on one of the most perplexing books of the Bible. Another great release from Liturgical Press.
