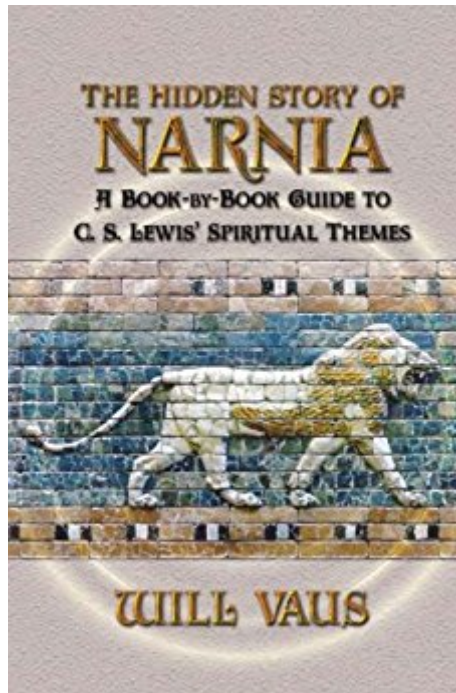

This book provides a fascinating review of the The Chronicles of Narnia Set, Books 1-7: The Magician's Nephew; The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe; The Horse and His Boy; Prince Caspian; The Voyage of the Dawn Treader; Silver Chair, Last Battle, with helpful questions for discussion at the end of each chapter. If a teacher, or a family, or a book club, or a discussion group of any sort wanted a helpful guide to the series, with good, thoughtful and reflective questions to ask and think about: this book is it. Recommended.

Vaus provides insight into Lewis' theology and his amazing ability to communicate deep philosophical and theological concepts in a way that a child can understand.
