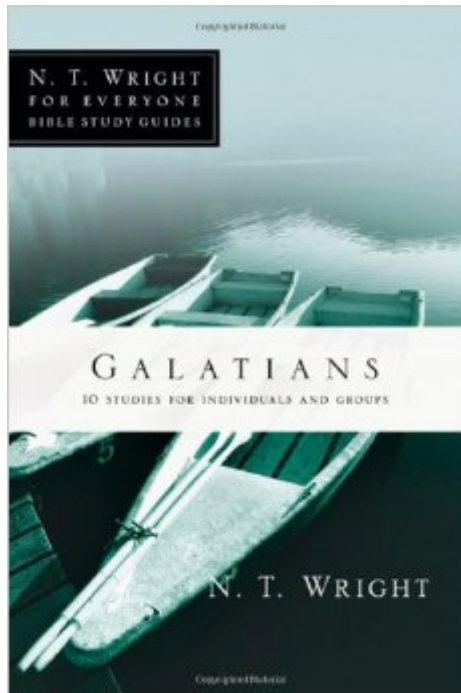

This book is a short series of paragraphs and questions designed for individual or group study. It is not a commentary. It should be considered a supplemental book to N.T. Wright's full commentary "Paul -Galatians and Thessalonians" (For Everyone series) which is the book I would recommend getting first. That book provides a verse by verse discussion with 83 pages on Galatians and 76 pages on Thessalonians. I am also finding William Barclay's "The Letters to the Galatians and Ephesians" in the New Daily Study Bible series to be equally and perhaps more helpful as a commentary. There are 68 pages on Galatians and 145 pages on Ephesians. The Wright and Barclay books tend to supplement each other rather than being redundant, and I recommend both. I am finding Barclay's book to be more substantial and satisfying as a scholarly but accessible discussion. Wright's book relates the text more to the contemporary world.

I am leading a bible study class on Galatians. It is not an easy epistle to study and there have been a variety of views and understandings. I have found N.T.Wright's guide to be very helpful. It is relevant without being simplistic, scholarly without be complicated, heartfelt without being sugar coated. I have found the sample questions in each section to be particularly useful.

NT Wright will blow your mind. He's brilliant but his writings are accessible. He provides a fresh and alternative perspective that we DESPERATELY need in the "west" and North American in general regarding how we approach the scriptures. Read this!

My husband and I used this as a devotional study for ourselves, and enjoyed it thoroughly as the questions are thought-provoking and require that you interact with and ponder the text. Due to N.T. Wright being so knowledgeable as I've read his other books, I did wish he'd share more of his knowledge and insights on the Scriptures in this book. However, then the study would not be so succinct, which is partly why we enjoyed it as it didn't feel overwhelming to go through. A good study of Galatians.
