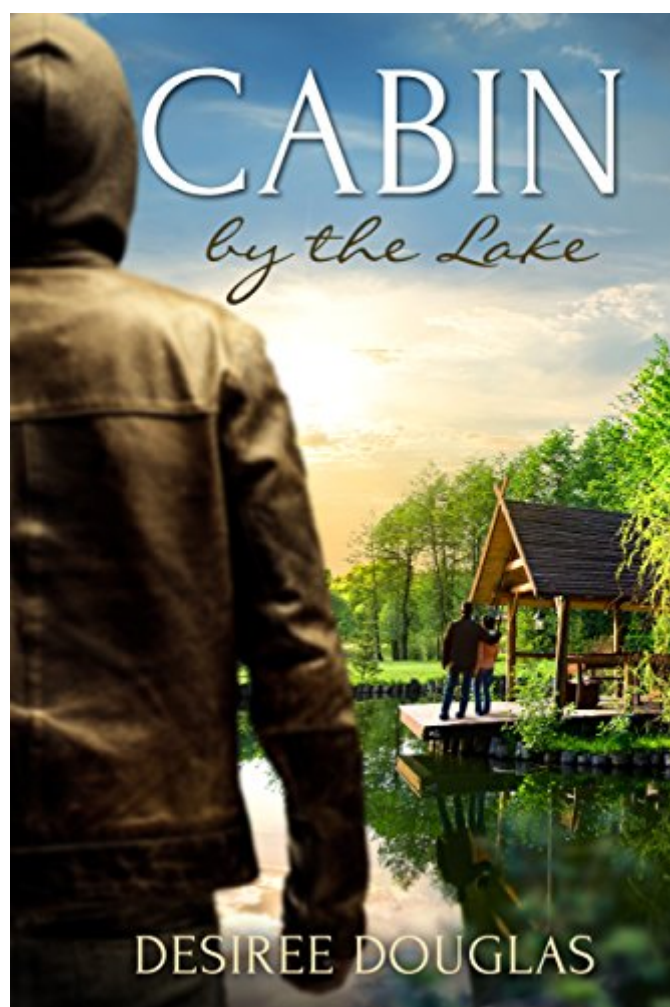

This book has both elements of suspense and romance. I was very pleased with how it was written and executed. I felt sorry for Lydia. I just want to strangle her mother for not appreciating both daughters equally. Mike comes in as a "passing-thru" type of guy. A man of mystery, if you will. But he's got a heart of gold for other people's welfare and he's certainly got eyes for Lydia. But Lydia isn't too sure of him at first. He's not too open about his past and she, herself, has a past she'd like to forget. All in all, a well-written story!
