DiAnn Mills is high on my list of favorite suspense authors. After reading some of the reviews for Footsteps, I knew it was not in the suspense genre. I decided to give it a try anyway as Ms. Mills is an excellent writer. Footsteps focuses on Debra's personal and spiritual growth. At the beginning of the book, Debra is a wimpy wife who thinks everything is her fault. She believes her abusive domineering husband is correct when he constantly tells her that she is not a good wife or mother. Readers follow Debra's progress as she becomes a strong determined woman through her new faith in God and with the help of loving, caring friends. Footsteps is a well written redemption story. Debra and Cale are fully fleshed out characters who are likeable and believable. Even though Cale is a Christian, he has his own issues to deal with. I can relate to Debra when she comes to fully trust in the Lord, and "hands" her children over to Him for safe keeping but still falters (wants to "grab" them back) at times. Very real-life. I am glad I decided to read Footsteps. It is a good coming-to-faith-in-God story. Looking forward to more of DiAnn's suspense books, though!
