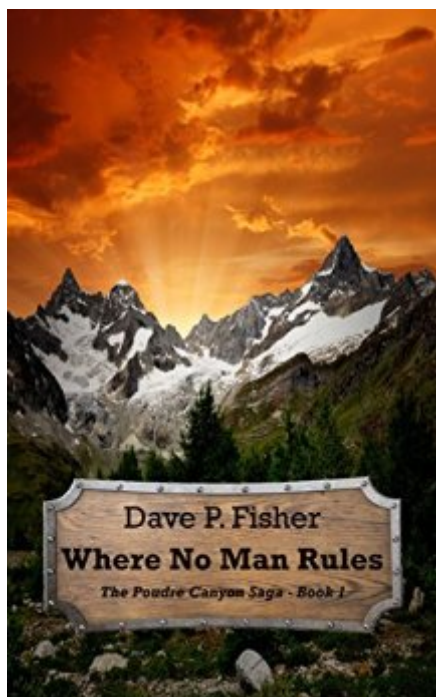

He raised his son Claude to be exactly his mirror image. People soon learned if you were an obstruction, the greedy Maurice or his son would remove you in whatever way necessary. The only competition was the Hudson Bay Company. The Voyageurs are the workers of the company & they were charged with the grunt work of the company. But, there is a fly in the ointment...it was the "Courier Dubois." They purchased no licenses from the fur companies & were free trappers & traders roaming as they pleased. They sold to the highest bidder & pretty much thumbed their noses at Maurice & his company earning themselves the handle of "outlaws." The final expedition of the year of 1824 was coming together & it was to be a most profitable year for the LeSeuer's.
