Very good resource if you're preparing for an overseas trip. Pictures, activities and questions throughout. Good quality. I bought these thinking it would be good for my 12 yo son. It was little below him though. We will still use, but would recommend for up to 10 yo.

The book is interesting, but I felt that rest of the Italy is not covered in as much detail. I would have preferred to have a couple of pages dedicated to each city, e.g. two pages for Florence, two for Venice etc. rather than an overall view of Italy. The guide for Rome is done really well.

I am very impressed with this series of books and think they are perfect for my 10 and 8 year old sons. It really covers the basics like language, money, food and culture then goes into detail about the main tourist sites we are going to visit. I love that it is interactive so the kids have to fill in pages, and there are challenges like find a statue and take a photo with it. The book is really going to help them learn about the culture and places they are visiting.
