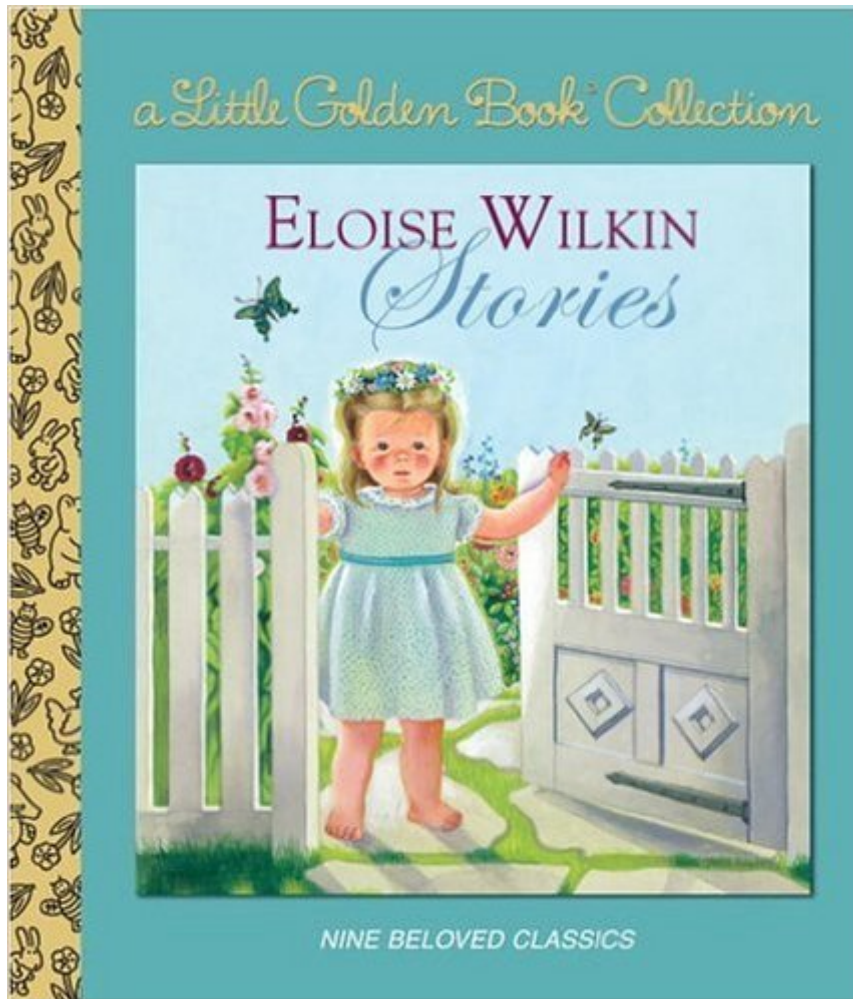

I love this beautiful book filled with images from a simpler, gentler time. I remember Eloise Wilkin stories that I used to look at as a little girl, that used to be my mother's books. So this book is very

nostalgic for me. I gave it a 4 since it left out her book "Prayers for Children" that I just love. I think this is a wonderful book to present to children today, as it shows loving families, and an affirmation that God loves his children.

I bought this book when my little boy turned one...I loved the drawings and stories. Such sweet tales here, such as "Busy Timmy", "We Help Mommy" and "Baby Listens". I remember Eloise Wilkin's illustrations from my childhood, so I was thrilled to find this collection of Golden Book stories. I only remember reading a couple of the stories before, so this book is a beautiful addition to my children's book collection. I do have one kind of big complaint though, which is why I am rating the book a 3 instead of a 5. Recently when I was reading some of the stories to my 15 month old, I noticed sparkles on the cover pages. At first I thought this was in the paper lining, but I soon realized that the metallic gold coating on the edges of the pages is coming off like dust. It was all over my fingers. I feel uncomfortable having my daughter touch the pages with me, as well as me touching the pages myself. What is this gold coating made from? The metallic gold sheen still appears solid when the book is closed (no white spots), but I wonder if the gold will hit a

point when it no longer powders off, or if it will keep happening until it's gone. Does anyone know about this? The book was printed or manufactured in China, which makes me even more nervous about what might comprise the gold coating. Any answers would be appreciated.

This is a wonderful collection, brought tears to my eyes to actually have this copy in my hands again! I plan to buy more for gifts.
