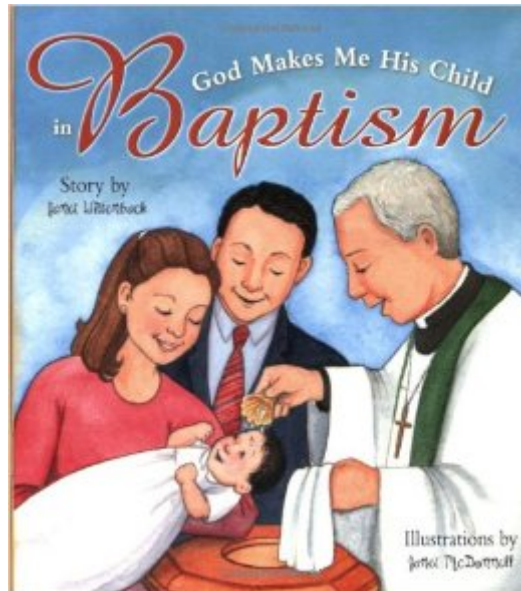

The book does a great job of explaining the meaning of Baptism as well as some of its on-going implications. It is also very nicely illustrated.
